Canadian NASCAR enthusiasts were in full force this weekend to support the first ever NASCAR sanctioned Dodge Weekly Racing Series at Montreal's Autodrome St. Eustache. North Gower's own Ken Baird and his # 63 Main Street Racing Monte Carlo were one of 19 teams to participate in this event.

Ken qualified for the main event with a lap time of 19.06 seconds, quite impressive for only the car's fifth lap around the track this season. This qualifying time secured Ken the 16th spot on the starting grid. The Main Street Monte Carlo was quick to move through the pack with Ken's sights clearly set on placing in the top 3. Ken aggressively moved from the 16th spot to 12th within the first 14 laps of the race before encountering problems with his power steering. Ken managed to hold his position until the 20th lap of the race before having to retire to the pit for repairs.

To spite the efforts of the Main Street Racing Pit crew, a seized power steering pump would be the end to a strong showing for Ken Baird in the first race of this NASCAR sanctioned series.
